This section of the CSAA History attempts to illustrate Medals awarded at the various Championships following an Italian Medal collector making contact with regard to the 1922 Medal he had found in a box of military memorabilia. This medal was solid silver and also engraved with the Winner's name and event. By the 1980s the medals just had the event details rather than winner's names!

It is interesting to see how designs have changed over time and also the shape of the medal, even with a calendar year.

CSAA Medals Through the Ages

1922 Tug o'War Medal

Inscribed "Civil Service Championships 17th June 1922 Inter Departmental Tug-of-War Won by R Fleetwood" He was a member of the Willesden Post Office Team and the medal was solid silver and selling on Ebay for c£160.00 (March 2021).

1938 Cross Country Team Medal

This Medal appeared on ebay in July 2021 and CSAA Committee Member, Dave Evans, contacted the seller and purchased. It was won by Derek Naylor, competing for the Inland Revenue, whose career was then interrupted by World War 2. It was in its original box which include the address of the provider.
